Since the first of January 2005, common rule awards have returned to Victoria, pursuant to the *Federal Awards (Uniform System) Act 2003* (Vic). Implementing common rule awards gives rise to a wide variety of practical issues. These include: identifying the appropriate award and interpreting the jurisdiction clause; knowing the categories of workers likely to miss out on award coverage, and who will remain with schedule 1A; whether common rule awards can be avoided; knowing how to apply the off-set principles; and considering whether AWAs are being used to override common rule awards.
