The introduction of the *Work Choices* reforms increased the role and significance of government action to enforce compliance with working conditions under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* (Cth). On a day to day basis this enforcement is carried out by the Office of Workplace Services (OWS), which is concerned in particular with freedom of association, termination of employment, transmission of employment, right of entry by unions, agreement making, and employers' obligations to keep and provide records.
